For Veterans Day (November 11th), we would like to have photos from our Veterans!

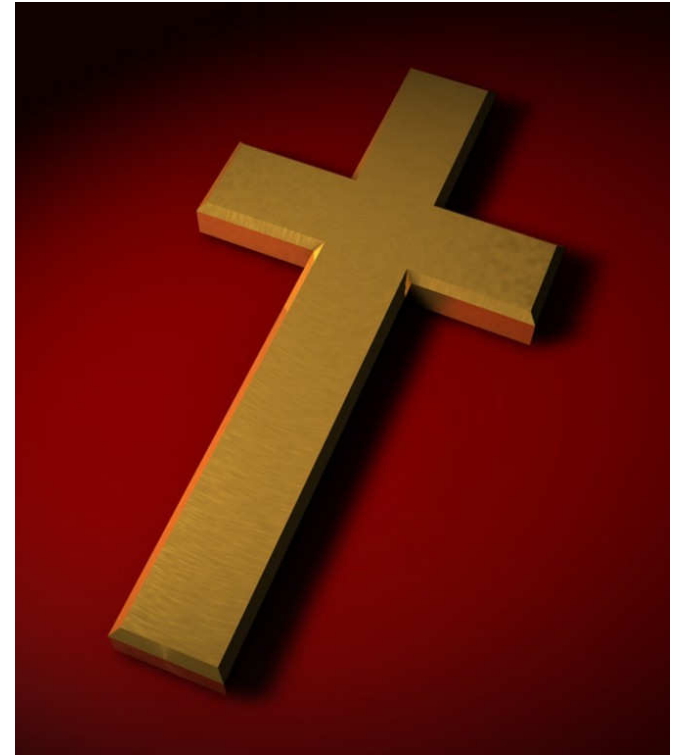

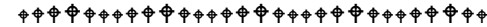
