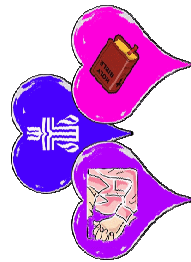


Thanksgiving Baskets

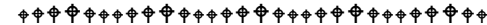
