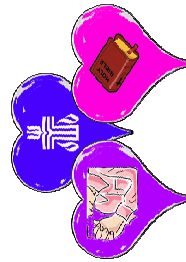
Bring in new mittens, gloves, hats etc. Children always seem to loose these items during the cold winter months! They are welcomed to help themselves to what they need to keep warm.
