Litany of Independence Day

- L:** *The forest and the streams, the rivers and the meadows, the valleys and the mountains, the fields brimming with wheat and corn, the great cities with their towering skyscrapers of steel and glass, the small towns with their rising steeples witnessing to Your presence among us—truly, O God, ours is a land that You have blessed abundantly.*
- P:** **Accepts our prayer of thanksgiving, O God, for the marvelous land You have given us to dwell in.**
- L:** *Many years ago the founders of our country gathered in Philadelphia to initiate a new experiment in government. They were people of faith— faith in the providence of God and the competence of all citizens to manage their own destiny— and possessed a vision of a land where the human spirit, created free and owing ultimate allegiance only to the Creator, would be free to reach its highest potential.*
- P:** **We are heirs of that faith and that vision. Yet we know that unless the Lord keeps watch over a nation, in vain the watchman stands on guard. Therefore, O God, hear our prayer.**
- ALL:** **Bless this land of ours, O Lord. Keep watch over it and protect it from the powers of tyranny and all that oppresses the human spirit. Grant us the wisdom to use our freedom wisely, to choose our leaders well, and to work for equality and justice not only within our borders but throughout the world. In the name of Jesus we pray. Amen.**
