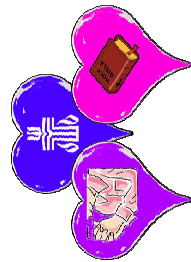

On **Wednesday, Oct. 14, at 4 p.m.** at First Presbyterian Church in Cedar Rapids, Rev. Berthe Nzeba of the Democratic Republic of the Congo will share her work sheltering, supporting, medically treating and empowering the many women and children victimized by rape and brutality in the aftermath of the Congo Wars. She will speak about the cultural burdens on women due to prejudice, how the exploitation of mineral resources in the Congo finances conflict, the obstacles of poverty, illiteracy, high rates of infant and maternal mortality, and what the Protestant church in the Congo is doing about it. "Maman" Nzeba is the General Secretary of the church's Dept. of Families and the first Protestant clergywoman in her country.

Rev. Nzeba is accompanied by Christi Boyd, Presbyterian mission co-worker in several African countries; she works to extend the right to hold property to widowed women and their children.

Nzeba and Boyd are International Peacemakers brought to speak in the U.S. by the Presbyterian Church USA's Peacemaking Program. Their visit in Iowa is coordinated by East Iowa Presbytery's Peacemaking Task Force. Your gifts to the Peacemaking Offering on World Communion Sunday have made this possible.

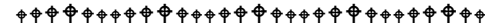
