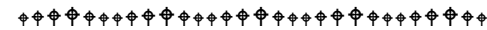

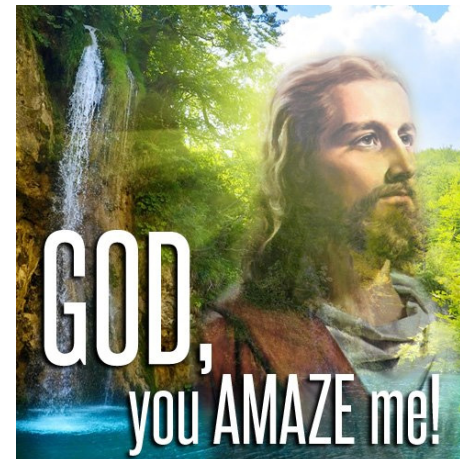
God loves a cheerful giver, but as our guest you are not obligated to give to the offering.
